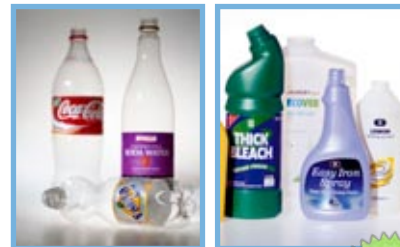
A full list of what can be recycled using the blue bin is below.

Glass including the following ✓

- **Glass bottles**
- **Glass jars**
All lids can also go in your blue bin

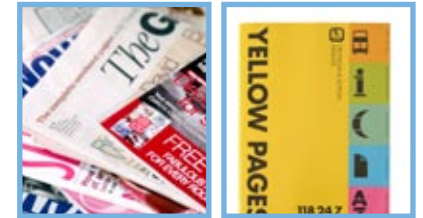
Plastic including the following ✓

- **Plastic Drinks Bottles**
fizzy drink bottles, milk bottles, water bottles
- **Detergent Plastic Bottles**
washing machine liquid bottles, fabric softener
- **Shampoo Plastic Bottles**
shampoo and conditioner bottles, hand wash bottles and moisture cream bottles.
No need to remove lids. Please rinse out and flatten where possible.
- **Other rigid plastic and packaging**
clean food and fruit trays, yoghurt pots, ice cream tubs and margarine tubs. Plastic toys and hard plastics such as flower pots and trays can also be recycled
- **Plastic Bags**
- **Other Plastic Wrapping, Polyethene, Cling Film**



Paper including the following ✓

- **Brochures and Leaflets**
- **Magazines and Newspapers**
- **Telephone Directories**
- **Books and Catalogues**
- **Shredded Paper**
- **Envelopes**



Metal including the following ✓

- **Aerosol Cans**
(body sprays and shaving foam - please ensure they are empty)
- **Biscuit and sweet tins**
- **Food and drinks cans (aluminium and steel)**
please rinse and flatten where possible
- **Metal pots and pans**
- **Aluminium Foil, Foil Food Trays**
Must be clean and free of food residue.



Cardboard including the following ✓

- **Clean Cardboard food packaging**
- **Cereal Boxes**
- **Cardboard packaging**
- **Egg Boxes**
- **Tetra Pak Juice, Milk & Soup Cartons**
Cardboard must be clean and free of food residue. Please flatten where possible.
