Mike Alexander will also talk about *Playing for*

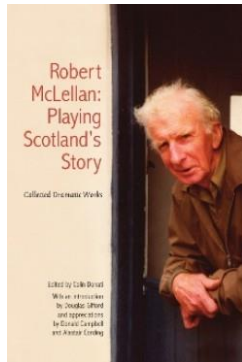

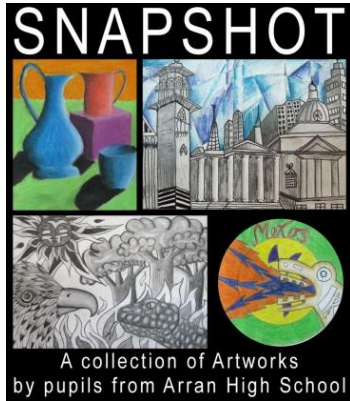

experiences of Arran people during WW1. Both humorous and poignant.

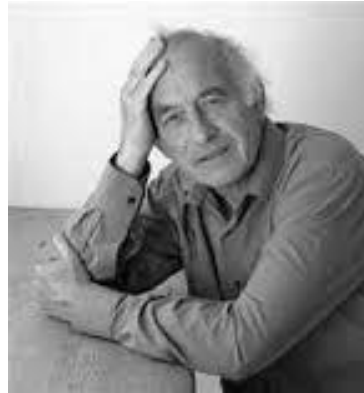
